My first two 'Kittels' I bought from Alwyn Bester. I was lucky that the hen's father was my choice of line that I want. Because these birds is so expensive it was not easy to start a family with them. My good friend Fred Coetzer shared a lot of his brilliant knowledge and agreed to sell to me at a very affordable price some of this outstanding genes that he imported. I am very grateful to him to have these family that are of the basis of Leo Heremans, Dirk van de Bulck and Stefaans Lambrecht. For someone who know these birds and there pedigree of origin, you will enjoy my collection of my so called "OLYMPIADE" pigeons.
